Types of dependencies in a Drupal project

- PHP packages
- Asset libraries
 - JavaScript
 - CSS
 - Fonts
 - Icons
- Development
- Non-development



Examples of PHP dependencies in contributed extensions

- Address (commerceguys/addressing)
- S3 File System (aws/aws-sdk-php)
- Migrate Source CSV (league/csv)
- Geofield (itamair/geophp)
- Sodium (paragonie/halite)



Improvements to Composer support

- drupal/core-recommended
- drupal/core-composer-scaffold
- drupal/core-project-message
- drupal/recommended-project
- drupal/core-dev
- drupal/core-vendor-hardening

- Chosen
- DropzoneJS
- Leaflet
- Font Awesome Icons
- Webform

Methods of including asset library dependencies

- Use a bundled library
- Use a content delivery network
- Download manually
- Use Composer
- Use NPM or Yarn



METHODS OF INCLUDING ASSET LIBRARIES

Use a bundled library

- License must be compatible with Drupal
- Examples:
 - CKEditor (Drupal core)
 - Bootstrap (Bootstrap 5 theme)



METHODS OF INCLUDING ASSET LIBRARIES

Use a content delivery network

- Popular CDNs: Cdnjs, jsDelivr, UNPKG, Google Fonts
- Examples:
 - Font Awsome Icons
 - CKEditor Plugin Pack



METHODS OF INCLUDING ASSET LIBRARIES

Download manually

- Library is committed into your repository
- Examples:
 - Chosen
 - Select2
 - Slick Carousel
- Drush command to download library sometimes
 - drush chosenplugin
 - drush webform:libraries:download



METHODS OF INCLUDING ASSET LIBRARIES

Use Composer

- Directly available (Bootstrap, Font Awesome)
- Asset Packagist
- Custom repository



METHODS OF INCLUDING ASSET LIBRARIES

Use Composer and Asset Packagist

```
"repositories": {  
    "asset_packagist": {  
        "type": "composer",  
        "url": "https://asset-packagist.org"  
    }  
},  
  
"require": {  
    "npm-asset/dropzone": "^5.5.1"  
},  
  
"extra": {  
    "installer-paths": {  
        "web/libraries/{$name}": [  
            "type:drupal-library",  
            "type:npm-asset",  
            "type:bower-asset"  
        ]  
    }  
}
```

METHODS OF INCLUDING ASSET LIBRARIES

Use Composer

```
"repositories": {  
    "chosen": {  
        "type": "package",  
        "package": {  
            "name": "noli42/chosen",  
            "version": "3.0.0",  
            "source": {  
                "url": "https://github.com/noli42/chosen",  
                "type": "git",  
                "reference": "3.0.0"  
            }  
        }  
    }  
,  
  
    "require": {  
        "noli42/chosen": "^3.0"  
    },
```

METHODS OF INCLUDING ASSET LIBRARIES

Use NPM or Yarn

- The right tool
- Updating is under your control
- Asset library not bundled with application
- Files must be copied



Copying files

- copy-files-from-to
- vendor-copy
- copyfiles
- cpx



Monorepo:
a software development
strategy in which the code for a
number of projects is stored in
the same repository

Why make a monorepo?

- Define an extension's dependencies within that extension
- Allows you to not be the dependency manager
- Future functionality in Drupal



How to make a monorepo in Drupal

- Define custom extensions as dependencies
- Define workspaces in NPM or Yarn



The future

- Managing PHP dependencies through a user interface
 - Drupal CMS Launcher
 - Project Browser
 - Automatic Updates
- drupal/core-recipe-unpack



The future

- Replace .info.yml with composer.json?
- Drupal extensions in Vendor directory?
- Standardization of management of asset libraries?
- Continued discussion and evolution
